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Thank you for prayerfully considering Friendship Christian School. We welcome your international application. The application process is quick and easy to understand and follow.

- 1st – fill out the application for admissions. It can be emailed or sent to us.
- 2nd- send a copy of the following items: All 8th grade and above transcripts, a passport, and bank statement for financial support.
- 3rd – After you email the above items, schedule your interview via Viber, Skype, WeChat, Kakao Talk or FaceTime. The TOFEL test is not required for entrance, but is required for graduation. If you have taken an English test and have the results, please submit these at the application time.
- 4th – Once you have passed the entrance interview and the transcripts and references have been accepted, we will need the upfront application and registration fees of \$1,520.00
- 5th – We send the I 20, letter of acceptance and I 901 documents for you to go to the F1 Visa interview in your country. Once the visa is obtained, you pay the remaining balance via wire and then book your airline ticket to come to America. Please notify the school office so the assigned homestay can pick you up at the airport.
