

Friendship Christian School Student Pledge of Conduct



The following are expected rules that every student at FCS, no matter their age or grade level, are to obey and follow. Not following the rules in the code of conduct and the school handbook are grounds for suspension and/or expulsion. Student rule infractions are subject to review via surveillance. Should a student be expelled for any of these reasons or any reason that violates the school's handbook, the tuition and any fees paid are non-refundable.

1. All students will practice honesty in their conversation and their classwork. Cheating is dishonest and is lying to the teacher about your work.
 - a. Students will not cheat in any class assignment, quiz, test, project or online assignments.
 - b. Student will not plagiarize (copy) someone else's work, whether it be from a peer, book, or online content.
 - c. Parents are not allowed to complete student work.
2. Students will not use profanity, inappropriate language, or dirty jokes on campus or at any school event.
 - a. This includes profanity in a foreign language.
 - b. This includes before school and afterschool sports or events.
3. Male students (see the family handbook for full details)
 - a. Do not wear earrings, colored finger nail polish, or have unnatural hair colors.
 - b. Do not wear outside clothes or jackets in place of the school uniform
4. Female students (see the family handbook for full details)
 - a. Skirts will be required to be no shorter than 2" length above the knee
 - b. Shorts are to be below the finger tips
 - c. Hair color must be a natural hair color (i.e., blonde, black, brown, or red)
 - d. Skinny jeans, yoga pants, and any clothing with frays or holes are not acceptable.
5. Students will be in dress code five days of the week
 - a. Dress code is checked daily by classroom teachers and on Wednesdays by Mr. Shaw
 - b. Those out of dress code will call a parent to have a change of clothes brought.
 - c. Students out of dress code will automatically color down for the day
 - d. Students with multiple offenses will require a meeting with Mr. Shaw and their parent or guardian
6. Students are not allowed to be on their cellphone or one belonging to a parent between 8:00-3:30.
7. From 8:00 to 3:30 all students are not to be on social media, watching viral videos, playing games on their tablet, laptop or computer; (the tablet, laptop or computer can be confiscated for a minimum of 24 hours in the school office). If a phone or electronic devise is confiscated, the student may lose it for a longer period of time and the parent or guardian must pick up the device from the office. Students may use electronics prior to school and during after school hours. All games, videos, movies, etc. are to be age appropriate, non-violent and not contain profanity or nudity. No phones, tablets, or laptop computers in the restrooms.
8. Students are not to taunt, bully, or use racial remarks. This includes physical or verbal abuse.
 - a. No students are to hit, push, kick, or make any inappropriate contact with fellow students in the building or on the playground. This is grounds for automatic suspension.
 - b. No students are to intimidate others by threats or name-calling. This includes face-to-face, phone, or online interactions.
9. Students are not to run, or use recess equipment in classrooms, hallways, the cafeteria, or in the church building.
