3rd GRADE SUMMER READING

Third graders need to read the book <u>A Mouse Called Wolf</u>, by Dick King-Smith.

As an assignment, on a piece of lined notebook paper students need to create an illustrated summary of the book. First fold the paper in half...

- On the top half of the paper students need to write their name, as well as the name of the book and the author. They also need to draw and color an illustration of a favorite part of the book.
- On the bottom half (and continued on the back if needed) they should write a few sentences telling about the setting, main characters, and a short summary of the beginning, middle, and ending of the story. Also include a review of whether or not they liked the book and why.

This assignment may be turned in at any point during the first week of school for an extra credit quiz grade of 100 if both portions are completed.
